Chung Wai Literary Quarterly (《中外文學》) has been internationally recognized in the form of being selected and indexed by ESCI (Emerging Sources Citation Index), which is a gateway to A&HCI (Arts and Humanities Citation Index) coverage. The inclusion of *Chung Wai* in ESCI will be initiated with content published in 2017 and continue forward.

Journals selected for this important new index receive the benefit of content discoverability via WoS (Web of Science, which houses many of the most well-known Scholarly Citation Indices), while continuing to be monitored for a potential future move to one or more of WoS's Core Collection's flagship Citation Indices, such as A&HCI or SSCI (Social Sciences Citation Index). More specifically, any citation to *Chung Wai* will now be discovered by, and included in, the citation count of other journals in other citation indices, including A&HCI and SSCI. To be included in various indexes is increasingly important to the assessment of the quality of a journal and the standing of the researchers whose papers are subsequently published in this publication genre. Inclusion in ESCI will in turn aid in our goal of extending the reach of this long-standing, prestigious journal to global Sinophone intellectual communities and broadening our ability to solicit distinguished authors worldwide, as well as top-tier papers in Chinese or in Chinese translation.
